Compare facts about these two animals. Use the language in the box to help you make sentences.

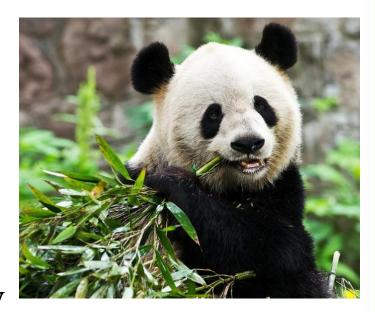


#### **Elephant**

- is 350 cm tall
- weighs 5,000 kilos
- eats 150 kilos of food a day

#### **Panda**

- is 150 cm tall (standing on two legs)
- weighs 100 kilos
- eats 10 kilos of food a day



### Example sentences:

This elephant weighs many times more than this panda.

(200 cm taller/shorter, weigh much more/less, eat much more/less, eat many times more)
