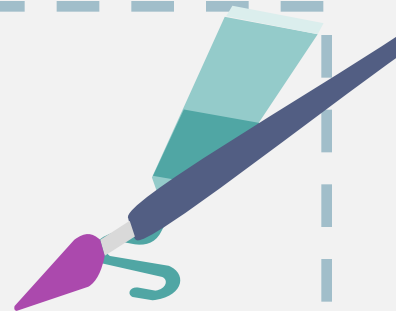

You can also invite friends to a party through the Internet. You can buy some online invitations, put pictures and videos in the online invitations and then




e-mail them to your friends.


Phone Call
