

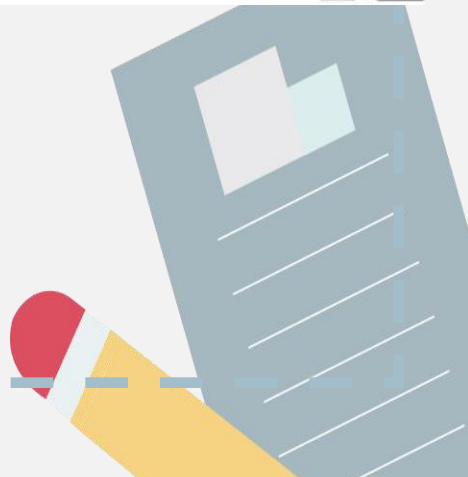

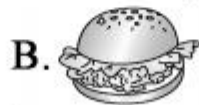

Do you know One Belt, One Road? We also call it the Modern Silk Road. And Zhang Qian was an early traveler of the Ancient Silk Road. He was probably the first 46 to bring back good information about the central Asian lands to Chi-

na.

In 138 BC, Han Wudi sent Zhang Qian to the Yue-chi people to ask for their 47 against the Xiongnu who often infringed(侵犯) them. 48, on the way to the Western Regions, he was caught by the Xiongnu people. Zhang had to stay with them 49 about 10 years before he got away. When Zhang finally 50 the Yue-chi in the North India, he was 51 to find that they didn't want to fight against the Xiongnu people.

On 52 return journey, Zhang Qian and his men were 53 again. It was not until 125 BC that they returned to China. 54 Zhang didn't finish his job, he learned a lot about the places, people, customs and cultures of the 36 Kingdoms(王国) in the Western Regions.

Later Han Wudi sent Zhang to the West again. Zhang's journey to the West helped 55 international trade, especially in silk, between China and the West. That's the Ancient Silk Road.

If the eyes are the windows of the soul, the body is the mirror of our feelings. If we are feeling great, we may give our body signals(信号). If we look at someone else’s body, we can often tell how they are feeling by their body signals. So reading body signals is a great tool in daily communication.

If you don't think that learning how to read and use body language is important, here are some numbers for you. 7% of the information we receive is from what people actually say, 38% from the tone and the speed of their voice, and 55% from their body language. The Hanging Gardens of Babylon(巴比伦空中花园) are one of the seven wonders of the ancient world. And these gardens are one of the greatest mysteries in the world. They are a large collection of plans that are hung from the walls of a palace in Iraq. Some stories described the Hanging Gardens were hundreds of feet tall, but some historians said that they were really not that high.

The reason behind the Hanging Gardens sounds like a fairy tale. A king built the gardens around 600 B. C. in order to make his wife less homesick(想家的). The king's wife missed her home in Medea where there were great mountains, so the king decided to bring the mountains to his palace. He ordered his men to build a huge hill and plant trees and flowers on it. Later, an earthquake happened in Babylon, destroying a large part of the city, including the Hanging Gardens.
