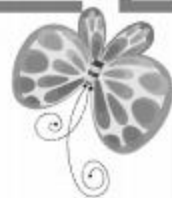


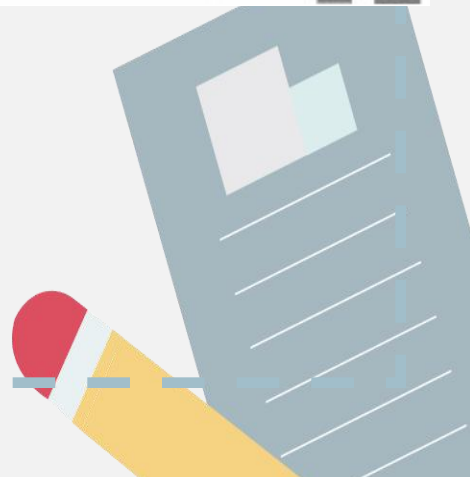

China has changed a lot in the years since I first moved here. One major development has been the adoption of cashless payment(无现金支付), which has changed the way we live and shop.

China is hardly the first country to have cashless payment. I used a debit card(借记卡) to pay for things without cash for years in the US. But now that I can use my phone instead, it's incredibly easy and convenient.

One of the things I like most is that I can send and receive money directly among my friends. It makes it so much easier to split the bill(分担费用) when we eat out together. And it makes it simple to make donations as well. For example, I often donate to a pet adoption

agency(宠物领养机构). Their official WeChat account has a QR code (二维码) that I scan to give them a donation.

But like all technology, cashless payment has some disadvantages as well. What happens if your phone gets lost or stolen? There are also times when your phone's mobile Internet connection, or the store's Internet connection, might not work.

Not long ago, I went to a nearby convenience store to buy some snacks. But when I got there, I found that the store's cashless payments didn't work and they could only accept cash. I didn't have any cash with me, so I had to give up and leave without any snacks.

So even though cashless payments are convenient, you should always carry a bit of cash in order to avoid any possible inconvenience.
